(3) The voters of Wayne County approved the imposition of a 1% sales tax to fund the above projects and retire associated debt.

Amounts expended for these projects may include sales tax proceeds, state, local property taxes and/or other funds over the life of the projects.

(4) The School District's General Fund advanced funded the James E. Bacon Modernization Project during fiscal year 2023 and 2024.

The expenditures were reflected in the SPLOST (July 1, 2019-June 30,2024) Project, but were funded using the bond proceeds approved during the new SPLOST of 2025, therefore the expenditures were moved to the SPLOST (July 1, 2024-June 30, 2029) Project.
